Budget

- Remaining budget for FY2020 will be carried over to FY2021 (JPY 4.7 million)
- Budget for FY2021 is JPY 6.0 million +4.7 million

Draft principle of budget execution under COVID-19 pandemic

- **Keep at least JPY 5 million for supporting travel (joint seminar, field survey, etc., late this year?)**
- **Supporting international travel for field survey/meeting/training workshop if situation permit**
- **Inviting young (or senior) scientists to transfer marine science technology** (after open border).

CREPSUM can cover travel and hotel, including quarantine period (if need)

CREPSUM will not cover vaccination.

Draft principle of budget execution under COVID-19 pandemic

Supporting:

- To print books, field guides and brochures.
- Publishing fee for review papers submitted in 2021.
- Publishing fee of peer-reviewed papers

Please remember no guarantee to support publication fee after March 2022 even submission is in FY2021 (dependent on the possibility of travel and JSPS policy for carry over of funding)

Predatory journals are unacceptable

- On-line training course, preparing training course materials

Draft principle of budget execution under COVID-19 pandemic

- Supporting expendables for joint studies, e.g., field survey in field sites in SEAsia and material analysis in other countries (difficulty in budget execution office,,,,, need to confirm it is possible in the scheme of JSPS)

Joint seminar

- Hope to have face-to-face joint seminar (on site+on line?)
- Or, on-line seminar (2 days?, Feb-Mar 2022)
